The demand for accountants in the job market is strong. The major prepares students for careers in public, corporate, or governmental accounting.

According to the Federal Bureau of Labor Statistics, accounting is the fastest growing profession. The job market for accountancy graduates remains very strong, even during temporary economic downturns. Options include:

Accountants are in high demand by government agencies such as the IRS, FBI and CIA. According to the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE), the entry level annual salary for an accountant is **\$52,900**. The median salary of a typical Accounting Manager in the United States is **\$89,521**.
